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CEO Stanley M. Bergman Delivers Keynote Address as Conference Forges Global Network of Senior Oral Health Leaders to Advance the Mission of a Cavity-Free World for Children

Besides Mr. Bergman, other speakers included Dr. Bruce Donoff, Dean of the Harvard School of Dental Medicine; Dr. Diane Rekow, former Dean of King's College London Dental Institute; and Dr. Tony Volpe, Trustee of the Global Child Dental Fund.

"The oral health challenges facing our global community can only be solved through a concerted effort by every sector of the oral health network, working from a shared plan towards a common goal," Mr. Bergman said. "By combining our efforts, expertise, and experience, we will each emerge from the Senior Dental Leaders Programme better prepared to further oral health literacy and access to care around the world."
